Acceptance for Re-Entrance of Former SUT Students

According to Suranaree University of Technology's regulations on accepting former SUT students B.E. 2549 (2006)

(Section 4) Re-enter requires the former student to exempt from student status within 2 years from the exempt. (However, those who is terminated from student status because of misconduct can re-enter when they are done with penalty)

(Section 6) File the request at Registration Office 30 days before the first day of the registering semester

(Section 9) Courses can be transfer if the grades are C/S or above. The amount of transferred credits should not exceed 1 in 2 amount of credits in the registered field of study.

(Section 10) Transferred courses will be recorded as 'ST' and accumulated with other credits gained from the new studying

Procedure:

- 1. Read the information and regulations of admission on various institutes
- 2. Complete the applicant form in www.sut.ac.th/ces
- 3. Print out the form and sign
- 4. Hand the form with transcript to Admission Office for verification
- 5. The office will print out course transfer form for students to fill in and hand back the form
- 6. When the admission period ends, Admission Office will gather all the files to the registered institute for consideration
- 7. The institute will give the result of consideration to Registration Office 2 weeks prior to the first day of semester. The office will announced the result on www.sut.ac.th/ces
