Chevening is the UK government's international awards scheme aimed at developing global leaders since 1983. Funded by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) and partner organisations, Chevening offers two types of award – Chevening Scholarships and Chevening Fellowships – the recipients of which are personally selected by British Embassies and High Commissions throughout the world. Italy: Jean Monnet Postdoctoral Fellowships. Deadline 25 October



The Robert Schuman Centre for Advanced Studies (RSCAS) offers one or two-year fellowships to postdocs of all nationalities who have obtained their doctorate more than 5 years prior to the start of the fellowship, i.e. 1 September 2017 for the academic year 2017/18. The Fellowship programme is open to post-docs, tenure track academics and those wishing to spend their sabbatical at the Robert Schuman Centre. The three main research themes of the RSCAS are Integration, Governance and Democracy; Regulating Markets and Governing Money; and 21st Century World Politics and Europe. Details [here](#).

The MULTIPLY Postdoctoral Fellowship Programme in Photonics is a Marie Skłodowska-Curie (MSCA) COFUND Action supporting international researcher mobility and training. Applicants from any part of the world can apply, and can choose their research destination and research topic. 9 European research institutes as well as research institutes from China and Saudi Arabia are participating in this programme. 5 PhD Positions Available in the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Innovative Training Network (ITN) META-CAN. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 10 October



This ITN is investigating the connection between cancer, metabolism and the immune system. For the next four years, a total of 15 young scientists in the fields of metabolism, immunity and cancer will be appointed and trained at the various participating institutions. As part of the research training, the consortium will conduct a set of hypothesis-driven research projects focusing on ONE question: **how metabolism is associated with modulation of cell death susceptibility and the immune response in the context of cancer.** Details [here](#)

United Kingdom: Training Fellowships in Public Health and Tropical Medicine for Researchers from Low and Middle Income Countries. ASEAN Nationals (except Singapore & Brunei) Welcome to Apply. Preliminary deadline 30 November



This scheme offers research experience and training to early-stage researchers from low- and middle-income countries. You must be a national of a low- or middle-income country and have a PhD and be an early-career researcher or a degree in a subject relevant to public health or tropical medicine and some initial research experience or a degree in medicine and be qualified to enter higher specialist training and some initial research experience. Europe: The EMBL International PhD Programme. ASEAN Students Eligible. Deadline 16 October




The EMBL International PhD Programme is Europe's 'best in class' PhD programme for the life sciences. 240 students from over 40 countries are carrying out PhD research at EMBL at any time. Every year EMBL accepts an average of 60 new students, who belong to the top science graduates in their countries. The typical duration of a PhD thesis at EMBL is 3.5 to 4 years. Details [here](#)

France: AgreenSkills+ Post Doctoral Fellowships in Food, Agriculture, Nutrition, and Animal Health.. ASEAN Researchers Eligible. Deadline 13 October, 2017



AgreenSkills+ is open to young experienced and independent researchers with up to 10 years post Phd research experience. There are no special requirements regards nationality, gender or country of origin. The mainly aim of those programmes is to attract the best young and experienced researchers from around the world.. Two types of fellowships: i) **Incoming fellowships** for researchers coming from all countries which apply to undertake a research project within one of the 300 Agreenium-IAVFF members' receiving labs in France; ii) **Outgoing fellowships** for researchers employed by one of the Agreenium-IAVFF members organisations, who wish to apply to work in a university research unit or research center outside France.
