

## SEED info sheet for exchange partners

Global Affairs Canada offers Canada-ASEAN Scholarships and Educational Exchanges for Development (SEED):

### Eligibility

- Candidates must be **citizens of an ASEAN** member state (Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, The Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, or Vietnam) and must be **enrolled full-time** at a post-secondary institution in an ASEAN member state.
- Candidates must demonstrate a commitment and capacity to use their studies in Canada to help reduce poverty in the developing countries of ASEAN and to achieve the **2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development**.
- For undergraduate applications, a written **student exchange agreement** must be in place at the time of application.

### Value and Duration

- CAD 10,200 for undergraduate or graduate students for one term;
- CAD 12,700 for graduate students for a period of five to six months; or
- CAD 15,900 for undergraduate students for two terms.

### Dates 2019

**February 26:** UVic application deadline (official deadline March 5)

May: final selection and results

Scholarship recipients may commence their studies or research between August 1, 2019 and February 1, 2020.

### Application Process

1. Fill out the attached "Scholarship Application Form"
2. Gather all supporting documents (listed on the application form)
