

Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

Code of Practice for Entry to Suranaree University of Technology during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak

Following Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Code of Practice for Gate 4 Entry (Kanlayanamit Gate) during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak dated on March 13th, 2020, it has been found the situation has worsened. Therefore, in order to strengthen the existing preventive and monitoring measures, Suranaree University of Technology (SUT) would like to replace that March 13th announcement with the new Code of Practice for Entry to Suranaree University of Technology during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak, as follows:

- 1. All the students and staff who use all the four Gates (Suranarree, Sri Thongchai, Wilaisila, and Kanlayanamit Gates) to enter SUT from 9.00pm to 5.00am are required to show their student/staff ID cards to the security guards at the gate before they are allowed to enter.
- 2. Staff and students without the student/staff ID cards are required to show other ID cards issued by SUT or other official units.
- 3. The security guards at all the 4 Gates are required to record all the entries by students and staff from 9.00pm to 5.00am every night.
