

Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

Preventive Measures at Student Dormitories during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak

Following Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Provision of Teaching and Learning during the Risk of the Coronavirus COVID-19, which requires teaching and learning of all courses from March 16th to April 19th, 2020 to be conducted through online multi-media learning system, and all regular classroom-based instruction to be suspended for this entire period, Suranaree University of Technology (SUT), in order to ensure smooth and effective operation for student dormitory services, would like to announce the preventive measures at student dormitories during the coronavirus COVID-19 outbreak, as follows:

- 1. All the student dormitories will be open at 5.30am and closed at 9.00pm during the period from March 16th to April 17th, 2020, or until further notice.
- 2. All the services for the students in the dormitory zone will be closed at 9.00pm.
- 3. For any student who does not comply with this announcement, his/her permit to stay at the dormitory will be cancelled for this entire period.

This announcement is effective from March 16th, 2020 onwards.
