

Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

Code of Practice for Gate 4 Entry (Kanlayanamit Gate) during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak

Following Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Provision of Teaching and Learning during the Risk of the Coronavirus COVID-19, which requires teaching and learning of all courses from March 16th to April 19th, 2020 to be conducted through online multi-media learning system, and all regular classroom-based instruction to be suspended for this entire period, Suranaree University of Technology (SUT), in order to ensure smooth and effective operation in relation to Gate 4 entry (Kanlayanamit Gate), would like to announce the code of practice during the coronavirus COVID-19 outbreak, as follows:

- 1. All the students and staff who use Gate 4 to enter SUT from 9.00pm to 4.00am are required to show their student/staff ID cards to the security guards at the gate before they are allowed to enter.
- 2. Staff and students without the student/staff ID cards are required to show other ID cards issued by SUT or other official units.
- 3. The security guards at Gate 4 are required to record all the entries by students and staff from 9.00pm to 4.00am every night.

This announcement is effective from March 16th, 2020 onwards.
