

## Suranaree University of Technology Announcement On

Code of Practice for Using Laboratories at the Centre for Scientific and Technological Equipment during the Coronavirus COVID-19 Outbreak

Following Suranaree University of Technology Announcement on Provision of Teaching and Learning during the Risk of the Coronavirus COVID-19, which requires teaching and learning of all courses from March 16<sup>th</sup> to April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to be conducted through online multi-media learning system, and all regular classroom-based instruction to be suspended for this entire period, Suranaree University of Technology (SUT), in order to ensure effectiveness in providing laboratory-based instruction in Trimester 3, Academic Year 2019, would like to announce the code of practice for using laboratories at the Centre for Scientific and Technological Equipment (CSTE) during the coronavirus COVID-19 outbreak, as follows:

- 1. All the laboratory-based instruction that uses the laboratories, equipment, and facilities at CSTE will be suspended from March 16<sup>th</sup> to April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020, or until further notice.
- 2. SUT faculty members and researchers can use the laboratories, equipment, and facilities at CSTE for their research activities during the normal working hours from 8.30am to 4.30pm.
- 3. In case there is a need to use the laboratories, equipment, and facilities at CSTE outside the time stated in Items 1 and 2, the Deans of the Institutes requiring those activities are required to provide a written explanation and a request for the use to the Rector or to the Vice-Rector in charge by stating clearly the users names and the period of use.

This announcement is effective from March 16th, 2020 onwards.
