

AGREEMENT
FOR
SCHOLARLY EXCHANGE AND COLLABORATION BETWEEN
SURANAREE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
AND
THE TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY

In recognition of common interests shared and as an expression of the desire to expand and strengthen the relationships between the two institutions, the SURANAREE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY and the THE TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY agree to enter into a program of academic exchange between two institutes.

The SURANAREE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY (hereinafter referred to as "SUT") and the THE TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE AND TECHNOLOGY (hereinafter referred to as "TUAT") will endeavor to promote academic exchange activities of mutual benefit. These activities are further described within the Memorandum of Understanding on Academic Exchange between SUT and TUAT.

Exchange of Faculty Members

Faculty members will be exchanged in the field of natural sciences, agriculture, engineering and other fields which each institution desires to encourage.

The number of faculty members to be exchanged will be determined each year by mutual agreement between the two institutions.

The nomination process will acknowledge the academic interests of the sending (home) institution and research and scholarly interests of individual faculty participants.

Exchange of Students

SUT and TUAT may nominate undergraduate and graduate students for study programs as non-degree exchange students. The host institution will consider these applications in accordance with its standard practice for admission of exchange students.

The number of students to be exchanged will be determined each year by mutual agreement.

Joint Research and Other Scholarly Activities

SUT and TUAT agree to encourage joint research and other scholarly ventures by members of faculty and staff. Since such joint activities will be unique, each proposal will be evaluated and executed on an individual basis.

Exchange of Publications

SUT and TUAT agree to exchange, on a regular basis, publications as agreed and specified by each institution. These publications may include catalogs, serials, and other library materials.

Extension/Evaluation

This Agreement shall be effective from the date of signature for a period of five years. The Agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two institutions. During these five years it shall be reviewed by the responsible committee of each institution. It may be terminated by either party giving 6 months notice to the other party in writing.

Financial Arrangement

No Party shall incur any expenditure on behalf of the other Party. Each Party shall be responsible for its own expenses incurred unless otherwise agreed upon prior carrying out the activities under this Agreement.

There will be two original copies of this Agreement, both in English. They will be considered of equal validity.


