

From Don Mueang Airport, Thailand


To Changsha Airport, China

In the same day's afternoon, we was taught by a Chinese teacher some basic Chinese language




On that day, we had a calligraphy class in the morning and a Kung Fu class in the afternoon.

Day9 (Nov 18 ,2018) : Another in Hunan


